ADOPTION OF ROAD SIGN REPLACEMENT POLICY

REGARDING INVENTORY, RETRO-REFLECTIVITY COMPLIANCE EVALUATION, AND REPLACEMENT

Whereas, Minnesota Statute Å§ 164.02 states that town boards shall have supervision over town roads ; and,

Whereas, Minnesota Statute Å§ 169.04 provides that town boards have the authority of reasonable exercise of police power and have authority to post signs related to traffic control; and,

Whereas, general authority to adopt ordinances intended to protect the public's health, safety, and welfare as provided in Minn. Stat. Å§ 365.10, subd. 17; and,

Whereas, the Federal Highway Administration's Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) Section 2A.08, requires the Town Board of Lynden Township to adopt a policy regarding road sign inventory, retro-reflectivity compliance evaluation, and replacement plan
NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of Lynden Township, Stearns County, Minnesota, hereby adopts the Lynden Township Road Sign Policy Regarding Inventory, Retro-Reflectivity Compliance Evaluation, and Replacement, as attached hereto, and shall be effective January 22, 2012.
