A RESOLUTION
REGARDING
RESPONSE *aka* COMPASS DELIVERY
FIRE SECURITY OF STRUCTURE

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute ("M.S.") § 365.10, Subd. 17 provides that the Lynden Township board ("Board") has the authority to promote the health, safety, order, convenience, and the general welfare of the township.

WHEREAS, a fire on December 11, 2012, severely damaged the building used by Response *aka* Compass Delivery located at 2314 200th St E, in Lynden Township, Stearns County MN (PID# 19.10600.0016).

WHEREAS, the Lynden Township ("Township") Building Inspector ("Inspector") in a preliminary exterior inspection of the building has found severe structural damage and contacted the owner Keith LaRonge regarding the securing of the building; and that as of December 25, 2012, the building was still unsecured; and furthermore, such structure remains unsecured as of this date, January 7, 2013, the Board determines it is in the best interest of the Town to secure this building.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lynden Township Board on behalf of its residents and business community hereby declares the Response *aka* Delivery site to be a threat to the health, safety, order, convenience, and the general welfare of the township and directs its Inspector to take necessary steps under his authority as Inspector and that granted by Minnesota Statutes and rules to secure the building at the expense of property owner.
