

**TOWN OF LYNDEN
STEARNS COUNTY MINNESOTA**

ORDINANCE # 4

Section 1. GENERAL PARKING PROHIBITIONS. It is unlawful for any person to stop, stand or park a vehicle except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the specific directions of a police officer or traffic control device in any of the following places:

- 1) on a sidewalk;
- 2) in front of a public or private driveway;
- 3) within an intersection;
- 4) on a crosswalk;
- 5) within twenty feet of a crosswalk at any intersection;
- 6) in a sign-posted fire lane;
- 7) within thirty feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop sign or traffic control signal located at the side of a roadway;
- 8) alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such stopping, standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
- 9) on the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street;
- 10) upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a street;
- 11) at any place where official signs prohibit or restrict stopping, parking or both;
- 12) in any alley, except for loading or unloading and then only so long as reasonably necessary for such loading and unloading to or from adjacent premises;
- 13) on any boulevard which has been curbed;
- 14) commencing on Eaglewood Road at County Road 44 on both sides of the road to the west or southwest terminating at the east or northeast edge of the driveway to 19286 Eaglewood Road as posted by signs;
- 15) commencing on Eaglewood Road at the south edge of the driveway to 18983 Eaglewood Road, both sides of the road, terminating at the north edge of the driveway to 18879 Eaglewood Road as posted by signs;
- 16) at any area of the public access on Long Lake with the exception of the three approved parking spaces, noted by the designation "Lake Use Parking Only" as posted by signs.

Section 2. Enforcement. Any Stearns County sheriff or his or her deputies, Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (“DNR”) or Minnesota State Patrol officer is authorized to enforce this ordinance.

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or section of other ordinances conflicting herewith are hereby repealed. Should any section of this ordinance be held unconstitutional or void, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be known as Lynden Township Ordinance #4 and shall become effective the day after its passage.
