A RESOLUTION TO ERECT REGULATORY SPEED SIGNS
Along HIDDEN RIVER DRIVE

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 169.14, subd. 2(a)(1) establishes a 30 m.p.h. speed limit on town roads in rural residential districts;

WHEREAS, a "rural residential district" is defined in Minn. Stat. ' 169.14, subd. 2(c) as:

"the territory contiguous to and including any town road within a subdivision or plat of land that is built up with dwelling houses at intervals of less than 300 feet for a distance of one-quarter mile or more";

WHEREAS, the town board has determined, as a result of on-site inspections, the following road or road segment is within a rural residential district as defined above:

Hidden River Drive from 146th Street South to Hidden River Drive intersection with and termination at Stearns County Road 44.

WHEREAS, as a town road(s) within a rural residential district the legislature has established the speed limit to be 30 m.p.h. without the need for a speed study by the Minnesota Department of Transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the town board of Lynden Township, Stearns County, Minnesota that 30 m.p.h. regulatory speed limit signs be erected on the above described road or road segment in accordance with the Minnesota Uniform Manual on Traffic Control Devices and that such speed limit shall become effective with the posting of such regulatory speed limit signs.
