

Resolutiion #2009-04
Lynden Township - Stearns County, Minnesota

A RESOLUTION TO ERECT A STOP SIGN
At Donaghue Drive and 17th Avenue East

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 169.01 Subd. 28. Local authorities. "Local authorities" means every county, municipal, and other local board or body having authority to adopt local police regulations under the Constitution and laws of this state, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes 160.02 Subd. 25. Road authority. "Road authority" means the commissioner, as to trunk highways; the county board, as to county state-aid highways and county highways; the town board, as to town roads;

WHEREAS, MS 169.01 Subd. 41. Official traffic control devices. "Official traffic control devices" means all signs, signals, markings, and devices not inconsistent with this chapter placed or erected by authority of a public body or official having jurisdiction, for the purpose of regulating, warning, or guiding traffic.

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute § 365.10 Subd. 17 provide that the town board has the authority to promote the health, safety, order, convenience, and the general welfare of the township.

WHEREAS, Donaghue Drive, a town road, and its intersection with 17th Avenue East, a town road, is devoid of any Official Traffic Control Devices, and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of town residents' safety and general welfare that Official Traffic Control Devices, specifically a STOP SIGN, be placed for east bound traffic along Donaghue Drive, at its intersection with 17th Avenue East;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the town board of Lynden Township, Stearns County, Minnesota that a stop sign be erected on the above described road or road segment of Donaghue Drive and its intersection with 17th Avenue East in accordance with the Minnesota Uniform Manual on Traffic Control Devices and that such stop sign shall become effective with the posting of such Official Traffic Control Devices.
